RENUMERATION

- 1) In case of re-engaged staff it will be guided by existing railway policy.
- For contractual staff it will be guided by railway board letter No.2017/trans/01/policy/12.04.2018 Where contractual staff is eligible for:
- Basic pay + DA+ other admissible allowances
- The remuneration will be further subject to provisions of minimum wages act / ministry of labors guideline and guidelines of railway ministry/ board from time to time.

NATURE OF ENGAGEMENT

- (a) The engagement is purely on contractual basis for three months only. The service rendered as Re-engagement / Contract of Para-medical staff is a arrangement for meeting up the requirement of the pandemic situation and it will not confer any right for automatic regularization/absorption in any circumstances. The full time Para-medical staff who enters into Contract / Re- engagement with the railways will not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term Contract / Reengagement. The Railway administration has full right reserved to discontinue Contract / Re- engagement at any stage.
- (b) First priority will be given to re-engagement of retired railway paramedical staff only, outsiders on contract will be considered only if adequate staff for re-engagement is not available.
- (c) The Para-medical staff shall undergo a medical examination, before the Contract / Re- engagement is entered into, for his/her to perform the work awarded to him/her.
- (d) All other terms and condition as laid in Railway Board's letter no E(NG)II/2005/RC-4/SC/2 dated 31/03/2020 and others as mentioned from time to time shall be binding upon the Para-medical staff.
- (e) After selection of the 63 Para-medical staff the names of the

remaining candidates who appeared in the walk interview will be kept on waiting list and in event of any vacancy arises in future will be filled by these candidates.

Candidates who fulfill above terms and condition and having requisite qualification should be present on the scheduled date time at venue with their original certificates (along with one self-attested photocopy of each certificates) of

- 1. DOB proof
- 2. Educational qualification (degree & mark sheets),
- 3. Experience certificate/Noc certificate (if already working)

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

During the period of contract either party (the Para-medical staff or Railway Administration) is free to terminate the contract on 15 days' prior notice. In case the Para-medical staff is found physically or mentally invalid or incapacitated the contract can be terminated forthwith. However if Para-medical staff leaves without notice or before completion of 15 days' notice, he/she shall be liable to pay the amount for the required period as per prevailing rates.
