

**DEPARTMENT OF PULMONARY MEDICINE

Applications are invited for the below mentioned post in an extramural project entitled "Effect of digital (mHealth) and paper-based self-management educational interventions on quality of life of patients with common chronic respiratory diseases (bronchial asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease) - A mixed-methods pragmatic, randomized controlled trial" funded by the Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB), New Delhi. The project post is purely on contract basis for up to one year (extendable up to two years or until completion of the project, based on the performance). Those selected shall have no claim for regular appointment (under SERB, PGIMER, or any other project) or any other entitlements other than the salary.

Senior Research Fellow (SRF): One post

Eligibility: *Postgraduate in Life Sciences or Social Sciences*
Desirable: Research experience ≥ 2 years
Cleared National Eligibility Tests (NET) for Junior Research Fellowship like CSIR, UGC, GATE, ICMR, DBT, PGIMER, and others
Experience in working at the community setting, rural and urban areas or technology-based interventions
Age limit: Below 35 years (5 years relaxation in case of SC/ST/OBC/PH/Women candidates)
Emoluments: *Rs. 40,060 per month (fixed)*

The post is primarily based at Ambala, Haryana for which no separate TA/DA is admissible other than the consolidated salary.

Interested candidates may submit their two-page resume, along with self-attested testimonials and other supporting documents at the Department of Pulmonary Medicine, R. No. 22, Level 4, F-block, Nehru Hospital, PGIMER, Chandigarh by 4 PM of 5th September 2022. The resume must provide clear and complete information on the candidate's eligibility and relevant experience and include a valid e-mail address and mobile number.

The interview will be held on 8th September 2022 at 3 PM at the Committee Room of the Department of Internal Medicine, Level 4, F-block, Nehru Hospital, PGIMER, Chandigarh. The interview will be conducted in physical mode following COVID-19 appropriate protocols. No TA/DA will be admissible for attending the interview.
